Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- In-process and final inspection of products to determine conformance to specified requirements.
- Quality verification of purchased materials
- First Article inspection using CMM and record inspection results in accordance with established procedures
- Review product manufacturing and quality records to verify completeness and acceptability
- Identify, segregate and document nonconforming material
- Interface with customer source inspectors and coordinate product acceptance.
- Assist Manufacturing personnel to ensure that all products and workmanship meet the respective standards.
- Read prints, drawings, sketches, specifications, packing sheets and other written and verbal instructions.
- Recommend changes to processes based upon findings.
- Perform other duties as needed.
